




CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

Type A: Bilateral Program

Introduction

This includes full or partial scholarships in accordance with the educational exchange agreements or consensus between the Chinese government and governments of other countries, institutions, universities or international organizations. It supports undergraduate students, graduate students, general scholars and senior scholars

Applicants shall apply to the dispatching authorities for overseas study of their home countries.

Scholarship Coverage

The Bilateral Program provides both full scholarships and partial scholarships. Please refer to Introduction to CGS—Coverage and Standard for details of each item.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health.
- 2. The requirements for applicants' degree and age are that applicants must:

 be a high school graduate under the age of 25 when applying for the undergraduate programs;


 be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for the master's programs;

 be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for the doctoral programs;

 be under the age of 45 and have a high school diploma (or higher) when applying for the general scholar programs.

be a master's degree holder or an associate professor (or above) under the age of 50 when applying for the senior scholar programs.

Application Procedure


- Step 1 Apply to the dispatching authorities for overseas study of your home country for CGS opportunity;
- Step 2 Apply to your target university for the Pre-admission Letter once recommended by the dispatching authorities as an eligible candidate (you will receive an Award Letter for CGS Candidate);
- Step 3 Complete the online application procedure (Visit http://www.csc.edu.cn/studyinchina or http://www.campuschina.org and click "Application Online" to log in), submit online the completed Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship, and print a hard copy. You should consult the dispatching authorities for overseas study of your home country for Instructions of CGS Information Management System for International Students and Agency Number;
- Step 4 Submit all of your application documents to the dispatching authorities of your home country before the deadline.

Application Documents

- 1. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship

 Those who are available for online application shall fill in and print the application form after submitting it online.(http://laihua.csc.edu.cn.)
- 2. Diploma and Academic transcripts (notarized photocopy in Chinese or English):
- 3. A study or research plan;
- 4. Recommendation letters from professors or associate professors.
- 5. Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form. The physical examinations must cover all of the items listed in the *Foreigner Physical Examination Form*. Incomplete forms or forms without the signature of the attending physician, or the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicant are considered as invalid. Please carefully plan your physical examination schedule as the result is valid for only 6 months.
- 6. The copy of *Pre-admission Letter* from designated Chinese university (if available);
- 7. The copy of HSK *Certificate* (if available).

Type B: Chinese University Program

Introduction

This is a full scholarship for designated Chinese universities and certain provincial education offices in specific provinces or autonomous regions to recruit outstanding international students for graduate studies in China. It only supports postgraduate students and doctoral students.


Application

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens and be in good health.
- 2. Applicants must not be students in Chinese universities at the time of application (or at least one year after graduation in China)
- 3. Education background and age limit: Applicants for master's degree studies must have bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35. Applicants for doctoral degree studies must have master's degree and be under the age of 40.





INTERNATIONAL CHINESE LANGUAGE TEACHERS (CONFUCIUS INSTITUTE) SCHOLARSHIP

Introduction

For the purpose of cultivating qualified International Chinese language teachers and facilitating Chinese language education in other countries, the Center for Language Education and Cooperation (CLEC) will continue with the International Chinese Language Teachers (Confucius Institute) Scholarship. Confucius Institutes, independently operated Confucius Classrooms, certain HSK test centers, Chinese language (education) departments of foreign universities, professional associations for Chinese language instruction of other countries, Chinese embassies (consulates) abroad (collectively "recommending institutions") may recommend outstanding students and currently-employed Chinese language teachers to study International Chinese Language Education or related majors in Chinese universities and colleges ("host institutions").

ELIGIBILITY

All applicants shall be:

- a non-Chinese citizens;
- b in good physical and mental conditions, and with good academic performance and conduct;
- c committed to the Chinese language education and related work;
- d between the ages of 16 and 35. Applicants currently working as Chinese language teachers shall not be over 45, while undergraduate student applicants shall not be over 25.





INTERNATIONAL CHINESE LANGUAGE TEACHERS (CONFUCIUS INSTITUTE) SCHOLARSHIP

SCHOLARSHIP TYPES AND QUALIFICATIONS

Scholarship for One-Academic-Year Study

The program commences in September and provides scholarship for a maximum of eleven months. International students currently studying in China are not eligible.

i. TCSOL

Applicants shall have a minimum score of 270 on the HSK test (Level 3), and an HSKK test score is required.

ii. Chinese Language and Literature, Chinese History, Chinese Philosophy, etc.

Applicants shall have a minimum score of 180 on the HSK test (Level 4) and 60 on the HSKK test (Intermediate Level).

iii. Chinese Language Study

Applicants shall have a minimum score of 210 on the HSK test (Level 3). Priority will be given to applicants who provide an HSKK test score.

Scholarship for One-Semester Study

The program commences either in September or March, and provides scholarship of a maximum of five months. Applicants holding the X1 or X2 visa are not eligible.

i. TCSOL, Chinese Language and Literature, Chinese History, Chinese Philosophy, etc.

Applicants shall have a minimum score of 180 on the HSK test (Level 3), and an HSKK test score is required.

ii. Traditional Chinese Medicine and Taiji Culture

An HSK test score is required. Priority will be given to applicants who provide an HSKK test score.

Scholarship for Four-Week Study

The program commences either in July or December, and provides a four-week scholarship. Applicants holding the X1 or X2 visa are not eligible.

i. Traditional Chinese Medicine and Taiji Culture, Chinese Language plus Home-Stay Experience in a Chinese Family, Special Four-week Program for Confucius Institutes

An HSK test score is required. The program may be organized and applied for by a Confucius Institute with 10-15 participants per group. Prior to the trip, a detailed study plan shall be made in consultation with host institutions and such plan shall be submitted to CLEC for approval.





JIANGSU PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHI

In order to further promote the development of international students' education in Jiangsu Province, enhance international attractiveness of Jiangsu higher education, create a "Study in Jiangsu" brand, make Jiangsu a main destination province for international students in China, Jiangsu Provincial government has set up the "Jasmine Jiangsu Government Scholarship".

1. Categories of Applicants:

- 1. Outstanding foreign students applying directly from abroad to study degree academic programs at Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine.
- 2. Foreign students applying to study at Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine in accordance to agreements of sister province/state.

2. Criteria of Application:

- 1. Already enrolled by Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine as self-paid, but not granted with Chinese Government or other entity scholarship students.
- 2. Foreign nationality citizens.
- 3. Education background and age limit:
 - Applicants for both college and undergraduate programs must have a senior high school diploma and be basically under the age of 30.
 - Applicants for master's degree program must have a bachelor's degree and be basically under the age 35. Applicants for doctoral degree program must have master's degree and be basically under the age of 40.
- 4. Applicants must obey the relevant laws of the PRC and meet the admission requirements of the host institutions. Applicants must have a correct attitude towards study and fine marks.

3. Application Process:

Log on to www.studyinjiangsu.org website.

4.Application Documents:

- 1. Copy of the passport;
- 2. Notarized copy of highest diploma/degree certificate. Applicants who still are studying, shall provide certificate from the school they are studying in. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English should be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English;
- 3. Score reports. Reports in languages other than Chinese or English should be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English;
- 4. Applicants planning to take master's and doctoral degree programs, must provide two letters of recommen dation in Chinese or English from professors or associate professors from the graduation school;
- 5. Other documents.





NANJING MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Introduction:

The scholarship was set up by Nanjing government since 2013 to attract and encourage more outstanding overseas students to study and conduct scientific researches in Nanjing Universities.

Prospective Candidates:

Non-degree students (1 year Chinese language students), undergraduates, Master and PhD candidates

Requirements:

- 1. Non-Chinese citizens who are healthy physically and mentally, and friendly to China;
- 2. Undergraduates who are not older than 28; Master candidates, 35; PhD candidates, 40.
- 3. Students who have not obtained any other scholarship granted by the Chinese government.

Benefits:

This scholarship does not cover tuition, living costs or accommodation; it only provides a monthly stipend. Master and PhD candidates will be granted 20,000 RMB/year, Undergraduates 10,000 RBM/year, one-year students 5,000 RMB/year, one-semester students 2500 RMB/semester.

- 1. The signed PDF version of the Nanjing Government Scholarship Application Form
- 2. The PDF version of the transcript of NJUCM, signed and stamped by the academic administrator;
